

**NOTICE OF FILING AN AMENDED APPLICATION FOR AUTHORIZATION TO RECOVER
ADDITIONAL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE FEBRUARY 2021 EXTREME WINTER
WEATHER EVENT**

Colorado Natural Gas, Inc.

You are hereby notified that Colorado Natural Gas, Inc. ("CNG" or "Company"), 10825 E. Geddes Ave, Suite 410, Centennial, Colorado 80112, has filed with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of Colorado ("Commission"), in accordance with the Public Utilities Law, an Amended Application to recover additional costs associated with the February 2021 Extreme Winter Weather Event through its Extraordinary Gas Cost Recovery Rider ("EGCRR"). The purpose of this Amended Application is to modify the EGCRR mechanism to allow CNG to include the Operational Flow Order ("OFO") penalties that were later assessed by Public Service Company of Colorado ("Public Service"). These additional costs, if approved, will be recovered over the next two years starting on January 1, 2023.

The State of Colorado and the surrounding area experienced an extreme weather event on February 13-16, 2021. As a result of the extreme weather, CNG incurred extraordinary and unanticipated consumption of natural gas by its retail customers during this brief period. As a result of the unanticipated and unprecedented consumption of natural gas by retail customers during that period, Public Service later imposed approximately \$1.2 million in penalties for exceeding certain tolerances related to the forecasted levels of natural gas deliveries to the CNG's Bailey/South Park and Pueblo West districts during the OFO period. If approved, the following shows the rates and bill impacts resulting from this amended application to recover the OFO penalty costs:
