

NOTICE BY COLORADO NATURAL GAS OF ADVICE LETTER NO. 150 FOR
APPROVAL OF TARIFF SHEETS IMPLEMENTING THE DEMAND SIDE
MANAGEMENT COST ADJUSTMENT

You are hereby notified that Colorado Natural Gas, Inc. (CNG) has filed Advice Letter No. 150 with the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (COPUC) for permission to file changes to the Demand Side Management Cost Adjustment (DSMCA) charges in CNG's tariffs. DSMCA charges reflect CNG's investment in conservation and efficiency measures that are required by COPUC rules. As the costs associated with these measures change, CNG must periodically adjust the DSMCA to reflect such changes. The DSMCA affects all customers and, if approved by the COPUC, will become effective July 1, 2026. The proposed rates are as follows:

Anyone who desires may either file written objection or seek to intervene as a party in this filing. If you only wish to object to the proposed action, you may file a written objection with the COPUC. The filing of a written objection by itself will not allow you to participate as a party in any proceeding on the proposed action.

If you wish to participate as a party in this matter, you must file written intervention documents in accordance with Commission Rules of Practice and Procedure. Anyone who desires to file written objection or written intervention documents to the proposed action shall file them with the Colorado Public Utilities Commission, 1560 Broadway, Suite 250 Denver, Colorado, 80202 at least one day before the proposed effective date.

Members of the public may attend any hearing and may make a statement under oath about the proposed change whether or not a written objection or request to intervene has been filed.
